Political Activities of Employees

The Board believes that District employees have an obligation to prevent the improper use of school time, materials or facilities for political campaign purposes. The Superintendent or designee shall provide administrative regulations concerning political activities on school property.

The Board respects the right of school employees to engage in political activities on their own time. Like other citizens, they have the right to use schools for meeting under the Civic Center Act. Such use shall in no way interfere with the use of the facilities for school purposes.

When engaging in political activities, employees shall make it clear that they are acting as individuals and not as representatives of the District. (cf. 1330, Use of School Facilities) (cf. 4119.1, Civil and Legal Rights) (cf. 6144, Controversial Issues)
