

Classified Personnel

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The primary role of classified personnel is to support and enhance the purposes and goals of the schools as adopted by the Board. (cf. 0200 - Goals for the School District)

All personnel policies and regulations pertaining to classified personnel must be written in harmony with that primary role.

The classified service shall consist of all employees in positions not requiring certification. The following positions shall not be considered a part of the classified service: substitute or short-term employees who are employed for less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the school year, campus and/or playground supervisors, adult education staff, full-time day students employed part-time, apprentices and professional experts employed on a temporary basis for a specific project.
