## Course Details

-oJanuary 19 - June 3
-oBlended online format - Meets one day a week face-to-face and the rest of the content delivered online
-5 Modules delivered online through district LMS Haiku
-oEach module lasts 3-4 weeks (total of 18 weeks)
$\rightarrow$ Face-to-face classes will meet one day a week from 3:30-4:30
$\multimap$ There may be an AMC summer session option depending on interest and student need

## More Course Details

$\multimap$ Test at the end of each module, plus a final exam
$\multimap$ Taught by middle school math teachers
$\longrightarrow$ Classes to be held at middle schools

## In order to qualify for placement in

 Algebra 1 in 7th grade, students
## must...

-obe in good standing in AMC by maintaining a grade of $80 \%$ or higher on all coursework
-oscore at an Algebra-ready level on the Scholastic Mathematics Inventory (SMI)
-operform at or above $90 \%$ on the algebra readiness assessment in May 2016

PLEASE NOTE: If your child is going to attend EI Rancho Charter Middle School they have different criteria for placement in Algebra 1 as a 7th grader. For these students, participation in the AMC is a good learning opportunity, yet it is not mandatory.
