OUSD to Host Jordan Elementary School Renovation Ceremony

ORANGE, Calif., September 24, 2008 – Modernization is complete, and on Tuesday, October 21, 2008, the Orange Unified School District will host a renovation ceremony at Jordan Elementary School to celebrate. A tour of the newly renovated facilities will begin at 5:00 p.m. At 5:30 p.m. the ceremony will begin, and Principal Bertie Anderson will provide opening remarks and introductions. Additional speakers will include members of the Board of Education and Superintendent Renae Dreier. Refreshments will be provided.

Jordan Elementary School was constructed in 1962 and has not experienced any significant site wide upgrades since that time. The Board of Education awarded modernization contracts to MGPA Architects of Carlsbad, CA and T & Y Construction of Upland, CA, for architectural and construction services on Jordan Elementary School.

The school consists of 23 permanent classrooms, four portables, Library, Computer Lab, and Resource Room. The scope of work included new energy efficient windows and HVAC units, electrical and technology upgrades to all classrooms, new floor and wall coverings, new roofs, redesigned administration and instructional spaces, new teaching walls with integrated storage and new ceilings with energy efficient lighting.

The total project budget of \$6.5 million was funded with approximately \$3 million from state funding sources and the balance (\$3.5 million) from District funds. The District funds consist of redevelopment area funds, deferred maintenance funds and the proceeds of a Certificate of Participation (COP) created specifically to fund modernizations.
