The Chamber Singers have been selected to sing in the “Candlelight Procession and Ceremony” at Disneyland Park in Anaheim, tomorrow, Saturday December 4th. In addition, the Orange High School Concert Choir, Chamber Singers and Advanced Women’s Ensemble will be performing with the Orange Community Master Chorale and Chamber Chorale in the City of Orange’s 16th annual “Tree Lighting and Candlelight Choir Procession” on Sunday, December 5th, at 5:30 pm, in the Plaza in the City of Orange.

Each year 14 to 16 choirs are selected from the hundreds of auditions to sing at the two shows at Disneyland. The choir from Orange High has had the honor of performing in this program for the last 29 years. A choir of over 750 singers and the Disneyland Orchestra will present the traditional Christmas story through song and narration in the Town Square on Main Street. Shows are at 5:30 pm and 8:00 pm.

Over 350 singers and the City Tree Lighting Orchestra will light the City’s Christmas tree and all the other plaza decorations. They also present the traditional Christmas story through song and narration. This year’s narrator is Dr. William Hall, Dean of the College of Performing Arts at Chapman University.
