The Board of Education requires written notification to parents regarding classes in which human reproductive organs, functions, and processes are described, illustrated or discussed [(BP6142.1(a)]. This may occur in units on reproduction and communicable disease involving HIV/AIDS and other sexually transmitted diseases.

Advisory committees of teachers and administrators have endorsed age appropriate district instructional units which emphasize that abstinence from sexual intercourse is the only 100% effective protection from teen pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases. In addition, course materials meet state mandates for AIDS prevention and abstinence education.
