CAL GRANT OPT-OUT FORM

Cal Grant gives funds to every eligible senior student who meets the requirement. A Cal Grant pays for tuition, room and board, or books and other supplies for California colleges. Cal Grant applicants must also file the FAFSA or the California Dream application between January 1 and March 2, 2017. (March 2nd falls on a Sunday - deadline is March 3, 2014.)

OUSD will electronically submit information for every senior in the district to the California Student Aid Commission so they may be considered for a Cal Grant award.

If you **DO NOT** wish to have your student's information submitted electronically, please complete the opt-out information below and return the completed form to your pupil's **High School Registrar by February 10, 2017.**

After that date, the information for all twelfth grade students, excluding those who opt-out, will be submitted electronically to the California Student Aid Commission for Cal Grant consideration.
