

Orange Unified School District Opt-Out Form Release of directory information to Military Recruiters

To: Parents/Guardians and Secondary Students

Federal laws require districts receiving assistance under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to provide military recruiters, upon request, with three directory information categories (student names, addresses, and telephone listings).

A secondary school student or the parent of the student may request that the student's name, address and telephone listing described in paragraph (1) not be released without prior written parental consent, and the local educational agency or private school shall notify parents of the option to make a request and shall comply with any request.

If you do not want to district to disclose this directory information from your educational records to military recruiters without your prior written consent you must notify the district in writing.
